Silverton Consulting has just revised two briefings and released a new Performance Results StorInt™ dispatch with the latest data storage performance results from the Storage Performance Council (SPC) and the latest file performance results from the Standard Performance Evaluation Corporation (SPEC) published benchmarks.

In the latest file (NFS) results NetApp and EMC are the clear winners in overall performance. BlueArc continues to dominate NFS performance at the processor-core level. Both perspectives are necessary to see the over all picture of NFS performance.

In the data (block) storage results IBM DS300 turbo is a surprising winner in both overall performance and in lowest response time. We also show the price per performance breakdown where Texas Memory System's has a surprisingly good showing.

The performance data is summarized in the StorInt™ Dispatch and fully analysed in the Storage Optimization and NAS Consolidation StorInt™ Briefings.
